As such, provides technical leadership needed to establish overall direction of architectural design, campus planning, landscape architecture, capital planning and related facilities initiatives. Coordination with various hospital departments and committees, city, county, and state agencies, consulting architect & engineering firms and related consultants, and construction firms. Leads project teams and mentors facilities planning team members.

Minimum Education and Experience:

Bachelor's degree in Architecture or Interior Design or related discipline, 10 years' experience in architecture / interior design / space planning or related work experience, demonstrated experience in AutoCAD designing with a proven track record of successful execution of projects, in-depth knowledge of Autodesk AutoCAD, AutoCAD Architecture, and other designing applications, working knowledge of MS Project software and ability to depict projects in schedule form, expert level experience designing and modeling healthcare projects using REVIT. Architecture license preferred, not required.

Special Knowledge, Skills, and/or Abilities:

- Knowledge of JC/CMS and FGI standards applicable to health care construction; state codes, standards and regulations.
- Analytical skills necessary to interpret and develop plans and specifications.
- Ability to read and develop plans, specifications and other documents related to construction projects.
- Knowledge of budget control and accounting normally associated with construction management.
- Interpersonal and communication skills necessary to lead a group to develop and execute solutions to construction problems
